The Tudor Consort - Thomas Tallis - Loquebantur variis linguis





# The Holy Trinity

One God reveals himself in 3 divine persons



1. A person must first be baptized in order to be confirmed?

2. Only bishops can administer the Sacrament of Confirmation.


#### Renewal of Baptismal Promises

- Do you reject Satan and all his works and empty promises?
- Response: I do.
- ▶ Do you believe in God the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth?
- Response: I do.
- Do you believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, who was born of the Virgin Mary, was crucified, died, and was buried, rose from the dead, and is now seated at the right hand of the Father?
- Response: I do.

#### Renewal of Baptismal Promises

- ▶ Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who came upon the apostles at Pentecost and today is given to you sacramentally in confirmation?
- Response: I do.
- Do you believe in the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting?
- Response: I do.
- This is our faith. This is the faith of the Church. We are proud to profess it in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- Response: Amen.

Confirmation completes the initiation begun with baptism.



The bishop is the ordinary minister of Confirmation.




The candidate is anointed with chrism.



► Confirmation can only be received once.




The Holy Spirit strengthens us to be true witnesses of Christ.
